*PLEASE NOTE: The Idlewild Foundation Scholarship Fund is available for undergraduate degrees and vocational/technical certifications only. No funding is currently available for post-graduate studies.*

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION COMMITTEE CONSIDERATIONS

**Applicant qualifications for consideration are based on active Idlewild membership, life style, and financial need including the following:**

- *Be a born again Christian and attending member, currently active in church, small group and ministries of Idlewild Baptist Church or a Bible based church attended while away at school;*
- *Demonstrate a financial inability to afford at least part of the cost of pursuing your chosen course of study;*
- *Be a high school senior, high school graduate or have a GED, or be currently attending college;*
- *Be a law-abiding person currently living a lifestyle that is not contrary to the fidelity of Biblical doctrine, Biblical moral purity or the unity of fellowship in the Church;*
- *Remain or become enrolled as a candidate for a degree at a Title IV school (i.e. a school that has an agreement with the U.S. Department of Education whereby students at the school are eligible to receive federal student financial aid to attend the school); and,*
- *If a previous recipient of a grant from the Fund, continue to demonstrate all of the above along with the pursuit of a degree in a chosen course of study by providing documentation, such as a college transcript showing classes completed, grade point average, and hours taken.*

**The Selection Committee will select grantees for awards based on consideration of the following:**

- *The level of participation in small groups and ministries of Idlewild Baptist Church as a member, such as completion of Starting Point, (previously called Membership 101) and Idlewild Groups (Bible Fellowship Class), or, if a member living away from home, the level of similar participation in a Bible based church;*
- *The level of financial need as demonstrated by FAFSA forms, income tax returns, financial hardship to the student and the student's family, and/or other personal or family factors influencing the potential grantee's ability to pursue their chosen course of study;*
- *The level of involvement in school and/or community activities;*
- *Prior academic performance, including standardized testing results as demonstrated by ACT and SAT score reports, high school and college transcripts, and academic honors and awards;*
- *Consideration of student's or parent's military service and/or public safety employment, especially when trying to choose between similar applicants; and*
- *The Selection Committee's conclusions drawn by each applicant's motivation, character, ability and potential, and his or her determination to obtain a degree and pursue a particular field of study.*

## SUBMISSION PROCESS:

1. Pick up an application at a Welcome Desk, Kiosk, or go online to [IdlewildFoundation.com](http://IdlewildFoundation.com) and print the application.
2. Complete the application and include all required documents which are listed below:
  - Your parent(s)/guardian(s) (if your parent(s)/guardian(s) claim you on their tax return) federal income tax returns or your federal income tax returns for 2015, 2016 and 2017;
  - Award letter(s)/notifications(s) for all other sources of funds you will receive, including but not limited to the PELL Grant, Merit Scholarships or Bright Futures;
  - FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) award letter/notification (type 'FAFSA application' into your browser for online application/information);
  - College fee/tuition schedule; and,
  - College (or high school) transcripts for the previous semester.
3. Submit your completed application with all of the required documents by no later than **October 31, 2018**. You may drop off your package at the Administrative Offices of Idlewild Baptist Church during normal business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm) or mail to:

- Emergency communication including an organization that operates the public interface emergency communications telephone system by providing the 9-1-1 and Enhanced 911 emergency telephone numbers;
- Office of Emergency Services (OES) which plans for and operates the Emergency Operations Center during calamities, disasters, special events and emergencies;
- Inspections and code enforcement, usually building safety, which includes construction, electrical et al. and/or vehicle inspections;
- Animal control, including wildlife officers, game wardens, and dog catchers; and
- Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV): includes administration of driver's licenses and license plates.

Upon completion of the Spring 2019 application process (**due by October 31, 2018**), each application package will be reviewed for completion. If you are missing any required documents you will be notified and your application will be placed on hold until the missing information is received. Your membership and ministry activity, either at Idlewild or at the church you attend while away at school, will be verified. The Idlewild Foundation Scholarship Fund Selection Committee will review all completed application packages for consideration.

Once qualified applicants are approved, scholarship amounts will be calculated and scholarship recipients will be notified by letter. All scholarship recipients are required to write a short letter of thanks that will be shared with donors of the Scholarship Fund following the distribution of funds to scholarship recipients.
