PLEASE NOTE: The Idlewild Foundation Scholarship Fund is available for undergraduate degrees and vocational/technical certifications only. No funding is currently available for post-graduate studies.

Summary of the Application Requirements and Process

Do I qualify for the scholarship? Can you answer YES to each of these criteria?

- Are you a born-again Christian who is attending and currently active in church, small group, and ministries of the church?
- Are you able to demonstrate a financial need to fully cover your educational goals?
- Are you a high school senior or college student? Do you have a GED?
- Are you a law-abiding citizen living a lifestyle that is not contrary to the fidelity of Bible doctrine, Biblical moral purity, or the unity of fellowship in the church?
- Do you plan to pursue a degree at an institution that is receiving Title IV funds? (This means that the students of the institution are eligible to receive federal financial aid.)
- If you previously received scholarship funds, can you provide a transcript that reflects your full academic record, including your grades and all courses attempted?
- Will you agree to write a thank you letter in the format we request for the donors to The Idlewild Foundation Scholarship Program? This letter will be due no later than the middle of the semester for which you have sought a scholarship.

How will the committee make its decision on my application? The scholarship committee will consider these elements of your application:

- The level of your participation in small groups and ministries of Idlewild Baptist Church, such as completion of Starting Point, and active participation in a Bible Fellowship class. If you are away at school, the committee will consider your level of participation in a Bible-based church.
- The level of demonstrated financial need as demonstrated by FAFSA forms, income tax returns, financial hardship to the student and the student's family, as well as other personal factors and extenuating circumstances.
- The level of involvement in school and/or community activities.
- Prior academic performance, including standardized test scores (like ACT and SAT), high school and college transcripts, and academic honors and awards.
- Consideration of the student's (or their parent's) military service and/or public safety employment.
- Conclusions drawn by your demonstration of motivation, character, ability, potential, and your determination to pursue and obtain a degree.
- Decisions by the scholarship committee are final.

How can I apply for the scholarship?

- You will find the application available at a Welcome Desk, kiosks, or online at IdlewildFoundation.org.
- Complete the application and submit all applicable documents. These are:
 - Your federal income tax return for the past three years. If your parents claim you on their tax returns, please submit their tax returns for the past three years.
 - Award letters and notifications for all sources of funding that you will receive, including PELL grant funds, Merit scholarships, Bright Futures. If you are receiving any additional funds, you must include that information.
 - Your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) award notification letter. If you are not sure how to do this, you may type 'FAFSA application' into a browser or go the Financial Aid office of your institution.
 - A document showing your college fees and tuition charges.
 - Transcripts of your educational experience. This may be your high school transcript or college transcript. If you have attended more than one college, please submit transcripts for each institution you have attended.
- Submit your completed application *with all required documents* by the deadline of **April 30, 2019**. You may submit your application package to the Administrative Office of Idlewild Baptist Church during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30AM-4:30PM). If you wish to mail it, please send to:

- Inspections and code enforcement, usually building safety, which includes construction, electrical et al. and/or vehicle inspections;
- Animal control, including wildlife officers, game wardens, and dog catchers; and
- Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV): includes administration of driver's licenses and license plates.

What Happens Next?

Upon completion of the Fall 2019/Spring 2020 application process each application package will be reviewed for completion. If you are missing any required documents, you will be notified and your application will be placed on hold until the missing information is received. Your membership and ministry activity will be verified. The Idlewild Foundation Scholarship Fund Selection Committee will review all completed application packages for consideration.

Once qualified applicants are approved, scholarship amounts will be calculated and scholarship recipients will be notified by letter. All scholarship recipients are required to write a short letter of thanks that will be shared with donors of the Scholarship Fund following the distribution of funds to scholarship recipients.
